TWO years ago, Scots comedy star Daniel Sloss saw two of his specials, Dark and Jigsaw, released in 190 counties and 26 languages on Netflix.

Today, the 29-year-old from Fife continues to push boundaries, with his stand-up show X being shown in Vue cinemas across the UK - a first for a British comedian.

Currently in New York performing a sold-out run of stand-up shows, Daniel spoke to us about his latest step towards worldwide domination.

# You've had two shows on Netflix but how different does being in the cinema feel?

To be honest, I can't watch it. It's too big, too personal. But it blows my mind it's happening. And I hope people get to see it and that they like the show.

I think if you look up the meaning of hubris, you've got your answer there pretty much all lined up. The show is coming together but I'll keep working on the writing as that can take a while to get those final jokes to the point where I feel it's fully cooked.

### You are infamous for your relationship routine. which has seen thousands of break-ups and divorces. Where are we now?

I update the tally on my Twitter account every now and then but they are still happening - 75,000 break-ups so far plus 130 divorces that I've been messaged about, People regularly bring their divorce papers to gigs for me to sign, I call them "release papers".
